## What Do You Do When God Breaks Through? Part 2

1 Kings 18:41-46

### 1. I \_\_\_\_\_ to what God says.

*"And Elijah said to Ahab, 'Go, eat and drink, for there is the sound of a heavy rain.'" (18:41)*

*"The word of the Lord came to Elijah: 'Go and present yourself to Ahab, and I will send rain on the land.'" (18:1)*

*"I will delight in Your statutes; I will not forget Your word." (Psalm 119:16 NRSV)*

*"I never turn my back on Your teachings. They will always be my most prized possession and my source of joy. I have made up my mind to obey Your laws forever, no matter what." (Psalm 119:110-112 CEV)*

Six commitments regarding God's word:

- (4) \_\_\_\_\_ intentionally
- (5) \_\_\_\_\_ intently
- (6) \_\_\_\_\_ deliberately

### 2. I \_\_\_\_\_ God's word as reality.

*"There's the sound of a heavy rain." (18:41)*

*"Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see." (Hebrews 11:1)*

### 3. I \_\_\_\_\_ God's message with others.

*"And Elijah said to Ahab..." (18:41)*

### 4. I pray God's word \_\_\_\_\_.

*"So Ahab went off to eat and drink, but Elijah climbed to the top of Carmel, bent down to the ground and put his face between his knees." (18:42)*

*"Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)*

### 5. I \_\_\_\_\_ God's promise to be fulfilled.

*"Go and look toward the sea,' he told his servant. And he went up and looked. 'There is nothing there,' he said. Seven times Elijah said, 'Go back.' The seventh time the servant reported, 'A cloud as small as a man's hand is rising from the sea.' So Elijah said, 'Go and tell Ahab, 'Hitch up your chariot and go down before the rain stops you.'" (18:43-44)*

*"The seventh time the servant reported, 'A cloud as small as a man's hand is rising from the sea.' ... The sky grew black with clouds, the wind rose (and) a heavy rain came on." (18:44)*

*"In the morning, O Lord, You hear my voice; in the morning I lay my requests before You and wait in expectation." (Psalm 5:3)*
